

## Regina L. Milio Scholarship Program

- Are you a GED graduate?
- Did you score 170 or above on each section of the GED Exam?
- Did you attend a local adult education or family literacy program?
- Are you currently enrolled in or accepted to a post-secondary education or training institution?
- Is your college or training program a Maryland accredited post-secondary institution?
- Do you need help with tuition, fees or books?

If you answered YES to all of the above, you may want to apply for the Regina L. Milio Scholarship Program. The program is designed to provide assistance to GED recipients pursuing post-secondary education or training. Each scholarship will provide a minimum award of \$500 to successful applicants. Scholarship awards will be made at the annual Spring MAACCE Conference. Recipients of the scholarship are free to choose their own area of specialization within any accredited Maryland post-secondary or training institution.
